CREATIVE DNA

The overarching theme of the ISCA Summer School is Creative DNA, which takes students to the very heart of art and design learning. The intensive two-week programme delivers Fashion, Art and Design with English teaching to introduce young aspiring designers to creative arts study and development of an exciting portfolio of work. This is delivered through a series of specialist workshops focusing on the realisation of experimental concepts across a broad range of creative subjects.

The Programme includes:

Art and Design:

- portfolio development
- primary and secondary visual research
- life drawing and fashion illustration
- mood boards
- 2D & 3D design realisation and presentation
- product development

Cultural Visits:

- professional artist and designer visitors
- museums
- art galleries

English support will be offered throughout the summer programme.

PROGRAMME REQUIREMENTS

Participants: 14 to 17 years of age. All classes are taught in English. Applicants whose first language is not English should note that they are required to be proficient in spoken English and be able to participate in group discussions. As a guideline we would recommend you to have an IELTS score of 4.5.
