

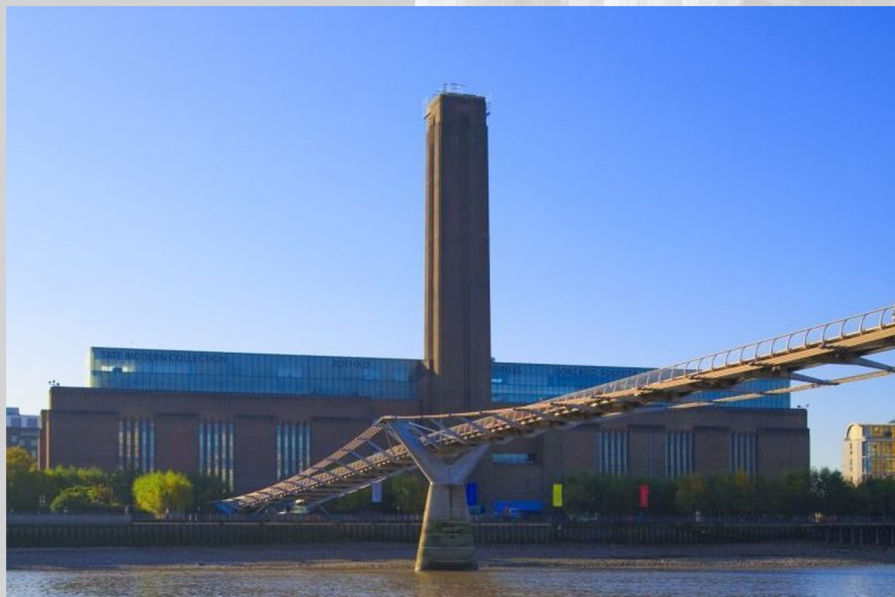
THINK DRAWING
